

Admission:

For Admission in this College candidates have to apply on prescribed Application Form obtaining from College office Counter on payment. The aspiring candidates have to appear in the conselling on fixed date as per schedule fixed by Ho'ble' suprem court of India. On the basis of merit list only selected candidate may be allowed to take admission in the college according to norms on the basis of seat of CML Rank.

Eligibility to take admission to B.ED. Course:

Graduates from any Recognized University, Agricultural University, Open University and Deemed University in, Arts, Science, Commerce, Home Science, Agriculture Science are eligible to appear for admission.

Along with the graduates, the candidates appearing for degree examinations of March/April of the academic year from any Recognized University, Agricultural University, Open University, and Deemed University, in; Arts, Science, Commerce, Home Science, Agriculture Science are eligible to for admission.

Candidates having equivalent degrees of the other Universities are not eligible for B.Ed course e.g. Sanskrit-Shastri Degree-Sahitya-Sudhakar.

For applicants open Category Other Backward Class (OBC) and Special Backward Class (SBC) Category minimum 50% in degree examination. For applicants of schedule caste minimum 45% in degree examination.

How to apply

Application form can be obtained from the college office as mentioned above. It is to be duly filled in by the candidate and submitted to the above college office along with all relevant documents e.g.

- ◆ Attested photocopy of the Matriculation/ICSE/CBSE/JAC or only equivalent board pass certificate, showing the candidate's Date of Birth.
- ▲ Attested photocopy of mark sheet of Intermediate (1.A/I.Sc./1.Com.)
- Attested photocopy of migration if the candidate has passed the last examination from any Board & Council.
 - Recent Colour stamp/Passport size photograph (6 nos.).
- Two Self addressed envelops containing stamp of Rs. 5/- for correspondence.
- Attested photocopy of caste certificate and residential certificate issued by the authority not below
- the rank of SDO. Candidates are required to fill only one admission form giving their order of preference.

Application forms should be submitted to the College office in person. All original certificate should be brought for verification on the day of admission. Incomplete and late application form or furnishing false information will make if liable to be summarily rejected without any information to the concerned candidate. In this connection no correspondence will be entertained.



Minimum Percentage Maths Examination:

For the applicants who have served as full time teachers for a minimum of two years, the above mentioned minimum percentage limit is not applicable. They only need to pass the qualifying examination.

Library:

Library is the heart of an educational institution. The college has a well equipped library on the ground floor of the building. The library hall consists of reading room stack room and the library office. The library provides seating arrangement for 60 students at a time.

Open Access:

The College has introduced system of open access where the students are allowed to enter the stacks and choose the books for themselves. All the cupboards of the library book stacks are open to facilitate free access of the students. The college has a well developed library, having a balance collection of books on subjects of prescribed study, current topic, philosophy, research, and about 20 periodicals, in addition to journals, on various topics and 3 newspapers, are regularly subscribed to. The library has a references section with Encyclopedia, books on general knowledge etc. In order to enrich the library, every year a number of valuable books on varied topics of study and interest are purchased on recommendation of teachers. The books are also purchased under UGC scheme.



Multimedia Jacilities:

The college is well equipped with LCD along with a computer installed in the lecture hall for the use by the staff and students. The college also has overhead projectors, audio equipment, a VCD player and television, and other equipments which are often used in the teaching-learning process.

Computer Laboratory:

The college has a state-of-the-art computer laboratory with internet connection facilities. The laboratory has sufficient personal computers with the latest configuration especially for the use by the students. The laboratory is also equipped with scanning and printing facilities. The laboratory is looked after by qualified faculties who also provide technical support.

Psychology Laboratory:

The college has a separate laboratory for psychology which has the all test Materials and the required equipments for psychology experiments included in the B.Ed syllabus.

Instructional Aids Caboratory:

The college maintains an instructional Aids laboratory containing instructional material such as models, globes, maps, charts, albums, roller boards, laboratory equipments. Mathematical instruments and other Teaching aids. These are issued for the use of the students teachers in their practice teaching.

Workshops & Seminars:

Rajeev Gandhi Memorial Teachers Training College conducts seminars and workshops to give the students an opportunity to familiarize themselves with topical issues. We invite resources persons to benefit from the expertise in their chosen field. Staff seminars are a regular feature of the academic programme.

The college also acts as a resource center and the faculty conducts seminar and workshops on invitation from neighboring institution. The Kendriya Vidyalya Sangathan invites the faculty as resources person for their in service refresher courses.



Conferences:

The college has many programmes to organize conference on the National subjects in the field of education. The programmes are organized with a high aim of creating an educational milieu punched with cultural fervor.
